We will also train you in all health and safety matters relating to the work you do, which will mainly helping to maintain steeple woodland nature reserve.

Each week you will be given a specific set of tasks and we ask that you perform these to the best of your ability.

Any problems that occur should be taken up with that weeks' supervisor.

We also ensure you that you are covered by liability insurance.

By taking part in Steeple Woodland Project activities you - the Volunteer - agree to:

- Carry out the work requested to the best of my ability;
- Give as much warning as possible if i am not able to attend a work party;
- Return all tools and other equipment used at the end of the work party or as agreed with the supervisor / site officer;
- Report any defect or fault in any tools used to abide by the rules of the project, including health and safety; and
- Abide by the group's safeguarding and equal opportunities policies.
